Announcement Trading Update Power Generation For January 2024

This announcement is made by CGN New Energy Holdings Co., Ltd. (the "**Company**") on a voluntary basis.

The board (the "**Board**") of directors (the "**Directors**") of the Company announces that, according to the preliminary statistics of the Company, the power generation of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "**Group**") on a consolidated basis amounted to 1,651.4GWh for the month of January 2024, representing a decrease of 11.5% compared with the corresponding period of 2023. In particular, power generation of PRC wind projects decreased by 13.2%, power generation of PRC solar projects increased by 14.5%, power generation of PRC cogen and gas-fired projects increased by 28.2%, power generation of PRC hydro projects increased by 14.3% and power generation of Korea projects decreased by 15.2%.

In addition, some of the Company's wind turbines were shut down due to ice coverage as a result of snow and ice conditions in central and eastern China at the end of January, resulting in a year-on-year decrease in power generation in January 2024.

- ^{2:} The capacity of the Company's solar projects increased significantly year-on-year in January 2023, resulting in a year-on-year increase in power generation in January 2024.
- ^{3:} A cogen project located in Jiangsu Province, the PRC increased its dispatch capacity compared to the same period last year, resulting in a year-on-year increase in power generation in January 2024.
- ⁴: The hydro project located in Guangxi Province, the PRC experienced a significant increase in water inflows in January 2024 compared to the same period last year, resulting in a year-on-year increase in power generation in January 2024.
- ^{5:} The Yulchon Gas-fired Project in Korea experienced a year-on-year decrease in electricity generation in January 2024 compared to the same period last year as a result of the decrease in the load of power grid dispatch in January 2024.
